Atoide

It is an online store like Play Store, nothing more than here you will find all the versions of the applications plus the pro versions to download or just know what it is briefly

Atoide is a "marketable" mobile application installation software application running on the Android operating system. At Atoide, unlike Google's standard Android Play Store, there isn't an exclusive, centralized store; Instead, each user manages his own store.

The software package is published by Atoide SA, a for-profit company incorporated in November 2011 and based in Lisbon, Portugal. There are several versions of the Atoide app: Atoide TV, an edition for smart TVs and televisions, and Atoide Lite, a faster and smaller version than the original version of Atoide.

Two more apps from the Atoide family were recently added, one targeting the virtual reality app market (Atoide VR) and the last targeting children where adult content apps are restricted and where younger ones can download apps, games and content. Children

The Android application used to access stores is open source, and there are several branches, such as F-Droid2. The communication between the client and the servers works through an open protocol based on XML.

The concept is inspired by the APTO package manager, which can work with multiple sources (repositories). When a user wants software, the client uses it to search for sources in which the application is stored.

The name Atoide consists of the words "APTO" (the Debian package manager) and "oide" (the last syllable for "Android").

It is used to obtain applications as an alternative to the Google Play store.

Atoide started as a proposal from Paulo Trezentos at the Magic Box Summer Camp 2009.

The proposal was accepted and would later become what is now Atoide. The first phase of development was developed as part of the SAPO Summerbits meeting.

The idea behind Atoide comes from different sources. On the one hand, the search for Linux installers in the European Mancoosi Project, another idea was Paulo Trezentos and his PhD project, in addition to the A5 Portugal Telecom telephony project, in which the team participated.

In late 2010, it was released on the Android Marketplace. This gave users the possibility to create their own store.

In August 2012, the Atoide and Android Bazaar brands merged to provide better communication.

In November 2011, Atoide joined the European continent.

In May 2015, Atoide announced that it would start operations in Asia by opening an office in Singapore.

In addition, as of 2017, the Atoide platform software has been downloaded some 6 billion times, has been used by some 200 million users, and is available in some 40 languages. In the different stores, you can find around 1 million Android applications.

By **Downloading Atoide** and installing on your mobile or pc you can find all the applications from previous versions to the latest free and paid versions too.

It is very similar to Google Play Store when you open the application you have the start, you can select News, Stores, Updates and Downloads. Aptoide is a safe source that has been used for a long time by a large number of people worldwide since it has constant updates.

It has a search engine in the upper part of the application where you can search for what you want to download it, simply enter the keyword of what you are interested in looking for and click on the magnifying glass, instantly a list will appear with the search results and you can choose which is the one that best suits what you are looking for. The good thing about the options that appear is that surely there are more applications than those that appear in the Play Store because perhaps they violated the policies and have penalized the developer.

Here we can search for all kinds of applications to download on our mobile. We recommend it 100% so that you can see and perhaps you may be lucky to find your favorite applications for free as well as many times it is possible to find applications that are of the paid version totally free.
